

WMIRS Image Management

Draft document, 19 JUL 2008

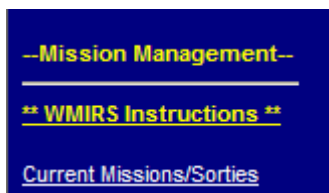
To upload images to the WMIRS[*ystem*], first connect the appropriate *equipment* to the computer from which you can access WMIRS. The most convenient method is to remove the memory card from the camera and utilize a memory card reader (e.g. a *SanDisk* product) connected via a USB port. I suggest not using the **manufacturer's software** to upload the photos to the computer's hard drive, but rather simply open the contents of the memory card as a folder and select directly from the memory card (use the **Browse** feature to locate the image files).

A quick safe backup technique would be to "drag and drop" the images into a temporary folder on the computer's hard drive.

WMIRS is accessed from the Missions Security System login page,

Note that permission must be granted to access the WMIRS (system) and varying levels of access are also employed.



Once you are logged-in, select **Current Missions/Sorties** from the left menu.

From the displayed list, find the appropriate mission, e.g.



Use the button to locate the photo **Image File** (e.g., a JPG file). Note that the image file name must exactly match the image data file name (as on the memory card).

The **Image Caption** can be composed as a descriptive comment.

Lat/Long must be entered in Degree/Minute/Second format.

Both caption and Lat/Long info. will be displayed on the image . . .once uploaded.

Image Viewable by Public? . . .for the time being, **YES** (why not? . . .depending on mission)
 . . .probably need to research this. WMIRS is not accessible by *general public*.

Use the button to complete the operation.
